


# An easy guide to installing and using the Soroptimist News App

- Click on it to open the play store


#### **App Store**




- On your iPhone or iPad you have this logo

- Click on Soroptimist News






#### Now you can Install

Install


 Installation takes a couple of minutes. When it is complete the green bar will change to "Open"






#### To open the APP

#### **Downloaded app**




- A shortcut, displaying this logo will be added to your phone for next time you want to use the App.

#### Once the App is installed


- When you open the App for the first time it will ask if you want to allow the App access to your photos. You can click deny to this question.

Professor Susan Black started her address by saying that 'the most successful people are those who keep going despite difficult situations. They are people who choose to stay committed to their goals'.



#### Three ways to navigate


2. When you've read to the bottom of an article click the coloured footer to go to the next article

Click on an icon to share the article via that method.






#### **Share on Facebook**

Note: you will be asked to log into Facebook the first time you use this share button.






#### **Share on Twitter**
