

Ideas for the Clubs

Shortly after February 24th and the Russian invasion of Ukraine, the S.I. Soroptimist International Clubs in Switzerland began to advocate for aid to Ukraine. This rapid reaction was particularly possible because the Clubs Chur, Kreuzlingen and Rapperswil have maintained intensive friendship and support contacts for more than 20 years.

Most local clubs are now involved in providing direct assistance to Ukrainian women in Switzerland. Among other things, they work together with the authorities and the

transit centers. So the **Club la Broye** equipped a house of the municipality and bought heating oil. Three women with their children have now been accommodated (see below). The **Club Jura-Région** accompanies an extended family with seven children, advises and supports them so that they can find their way around. In addition, considerable amounts flow into the donation account for Ukraine again and again (see below).

What happens next with the many ideas, projects but also experiences? Soon these will be available on a platform of the clubs. This gives the clubs the opportunity to network directly.

Finances

The great commitment of the clubs to Ukrainian Soroptimists and to the Ukrainian population is also reflected in figures. By the beginning of May, around CHF 120,000 had been paid into the Union's Ukraine account by the Swiss Clubs S.I. In total, donations totalling CHF 332,000 and almost EUR 30,000 were recorded in the Ukraine account. 138,000 SFr. and 30,000 euros were spent on various aid campaigns
