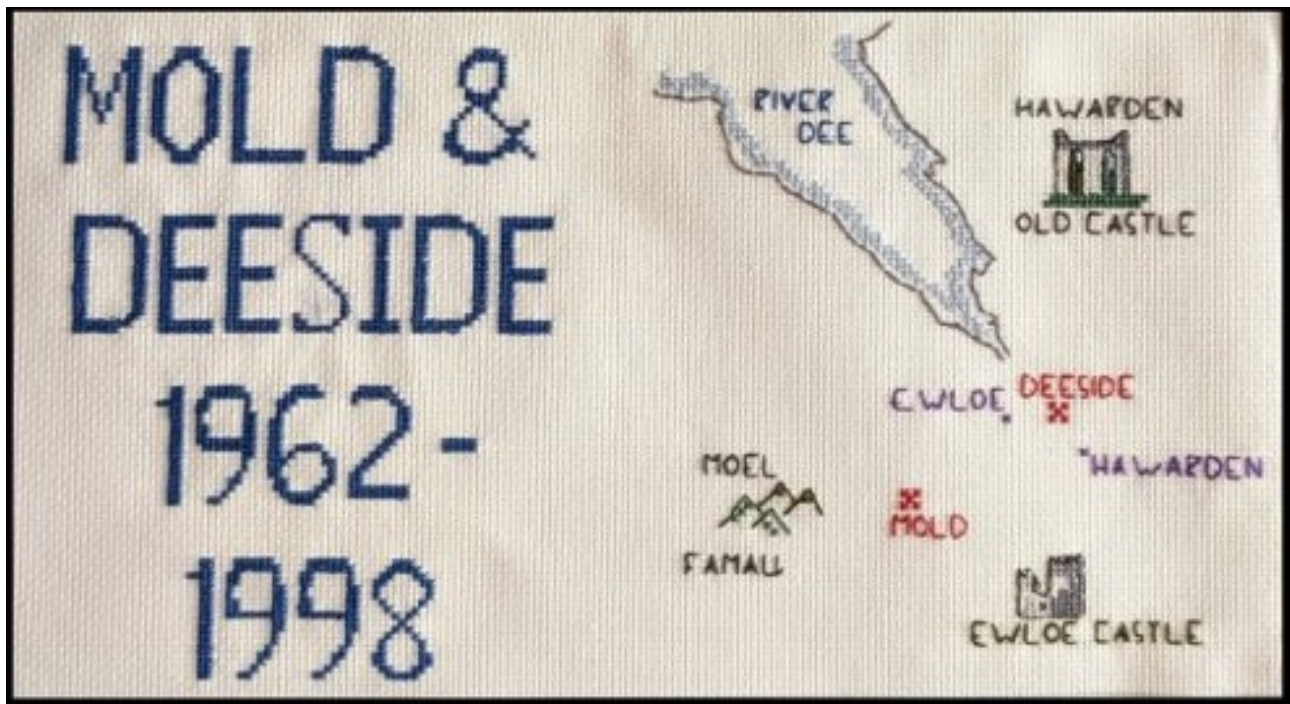


SI MOLD and DEESIDE



SI Mold and Deeside was Chartered in 1962 and closed in 1998.

I was unable to find out what was on the Club Regalia, or any history of the club.

I chose to sew a map showing the area and some well-known historical landmarks.

Moel Famau is the highest hill in the Clwydian Range and is an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The Offa's Dyke Long Distance Footpath crosses its summit.

Ewloe Castle was built between 1210 and 1270, partly by Llewelyn the Great, when the borderlands were hotly contested between the Welsh and the English.

There are 2 Hawarden castles. The original castle site goes back to the Iron Age. There is a Norman Motte, the site was fully fortified by 1280 and played its part in the Civil War when it was partially destroyed. The new castle is a stately home built on the estate and was, most famously, home to W E Gladstone, a British Prime Minister.
