The success of the **Oor Wullie Bucket Trail** has been completely dependent on the generous participation and exceptional contribution of many people and communities across the region.

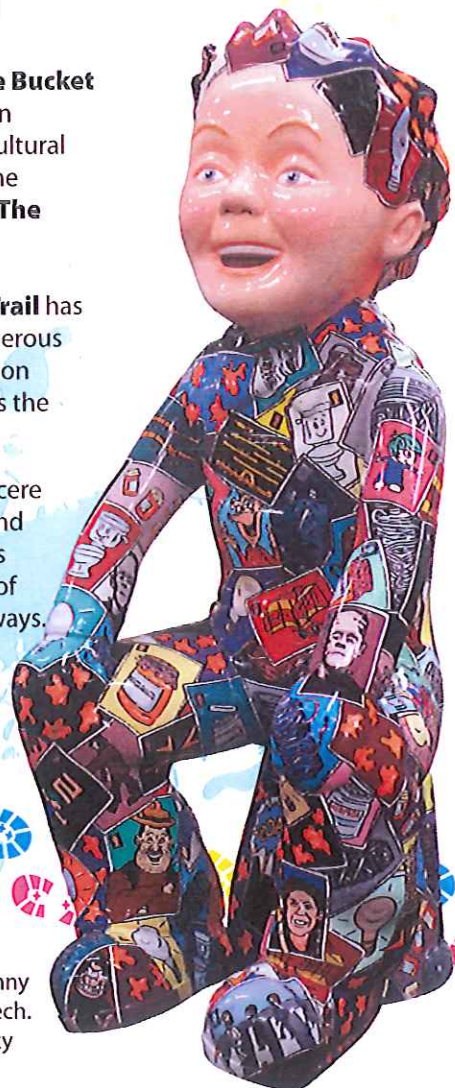
