- **LEARN**
 - Invite an **IJM speaker** to your club/regional meeting
 - Host a **TED Talk Screening & Discussion** – using Gary Haugen's TED Talk and discussion questions set by IJM
 - Receive **monthly updates** from IJM's field offices around the world
- **FUNDRAISE**
 - Host a **Freedom Party** – an opportunity to sell goods made by survivors of human trafficking who are now living in freedom and making beautiful products
 - **Set an appropriate fundraising target** to support our work in Mumbai (Casework: Sex Trafficking) or Chennai (Casework: Bonded Labour Slavery)
- **CAMPAIGN**
 - Promote & gather signatures among your networks for IJM's **Government Advocacy Campaigns** addressing the plague of everyday violence
