Pat Midgely moved into Pilot Street, the centre of the once thriving fisherfolk quarter of Lynn, in 1965. She discovered that two of the original fishing cottages had survived but were under threat. With a group of fellow enthusiasts she set up the North End Trust to save them. Gaining support with slide shows in the local pubs she eventually received the backing of the local MP, the borough council and English Heritage and the cottages were saved. True's Yard Fisherfolk Museum was opened on March 31st 1991 and remains a popular attraction
