President Alison's Message

'Inside Out and Outside In'

I am a trustee of the charity ABCD (Action around Bethlehem Children with Disability). For nearly 40 years, we have been working through local partners across Palestine to improve the lives of children with physical, special educational and psychological disabilities, regardless of their faith, race, or gender.

During the last 2 decades our reach has extended to establish rehabilitation centres in five refugee camps in the West Bank. Our most recent partners at the Deir Ammar camp in the south of the region are now in a position to start equipping a sensory room, funded by ABCD. A qualified speech and language therapist has just been appointed and my regional project is to sponsor her salary for a year and also if possible further training in trauma counselling.

At some stage in the future, we hope she will be able to instruct therapists in other refugee camps. I shall be applying to an educational trust for matched funding, so hopefully all donations from SISEE members to this project will be doubled.

ABCD's founding trustee and our project manager will be our keynote speakers at the regional meeting when full background to the charity will be shared and the project will be officially launched. Your support will be hugely appreciated. Thank you.
