What is the deadline for getting approved biogs and photos back to you?

There isn't a deadline as such, we are working on them as they come in and the names will be grouped in batches and put on the website over coming months. With so many to work through we thought it would be easiest to group them as we get them in. Please send the info as soon as it is ready so we can add it to our upload list.

I nominated a member from another Club, how will I know when she is being published?

At the same time as contacting the Club of the nominee, we will be contacting the person making the nomination so you will be notified.

Where will the certificate be sent – to the Club, nominee or nominator?

A hard copy of the certificate will be sent to the Club of the nominee as well as a scanned version of the certificate for use on your website and in social media as well as for sending out with your Club press release.

Will you be publishing this year – or next year 2021 during the centenary year?

We are starting in September this year and will run through to October 2021.

Can we promote this on our Club/Region website?

Yes, please do and please link to the Centenary website too.

Is there an Award for these women?

There isn't an Award as such, but there will be a certificate signed by the Federation President. The plan is to celebrate these women by publishing their stories on the SIGBI Centenary website, which we will do in batches, some each month as they come in up to 2021. We will let you know when your submissions are going to be published so you can promote it locally. We will be promoting each monthly 'batch' of women so please retweet, like and share SIGBI social media posts too.

How will I know if one of our Club members' biogs is being published on Wikipedia?

We have a small team of Wikipedia editors and one of them will contact the member making the nomination to seek any further information and consents that may be required.

Which women's stories will be published on Wikipedia?

The panel has reviewed all the nominations and made their decisions based on whether they meet the Wikipedia publication criteria. We will let you know if your submission is to be submitted to Wikipedia as further references and permissions will be required at that stage.
