Safeguarding

 Safeguarding is the term used to denote measures to protect the health, well being and human rights of individuals which allow people especially children, young people and vulnerable adults to live free from abuse harm and neglect.

Predatory Marriage

 where a vulnerable person is exploited by someone who induces them to marry purely for financial benefit, usually to gain access to their estate after death'





Campaign by Daphne Franks

- Campaign to reform marriage laws & procedures in UK to protect people with dementia
- Mother age 91 with dementia & terminal cancer
- After her death family discovered man age 68 had secretly married her 5 months before





Campaign by Daphne Franks

- Change law so marriage does not revoke a Will
- Make Predatory Marriage a criminal offence (?subset of Forced Marriage)
- Train Registrars to look for insufficient mental capacity to consent
- Robust questions for Registrars to ask at marriage
