
Saturday 12th September: Day 1


END: Transporter Bridge on the North Side.


END: Transporter Bridge on the North Side.

VIA: England Coast Path, past Hartlepool Golf Club


END: Crimdon Dene Caravan Park public parking A1086


VIA: England Coast Path (also Durham Coast Path), Horden Point, Shot Rock, Foxholes Dene

VIA: England Coast Path Nose's Point




END: National Glass Centre Car Park, Sunderland






