### Samantha and Summer

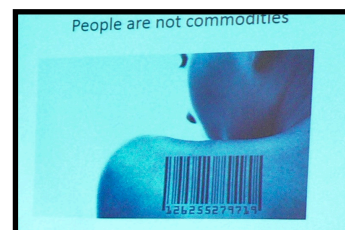
We heard about how the little horse visits residential homes and special schools and the very favourable reaction it can invoke. A number of the Care Home had been invited to meet Summer.
