What is a Library of Things?

- A Library, but with Things!
 - A place where you can borrow objects instead of books
- The Things are particularly items you might use infrequently, such as:
 - Household and garden tools
 - Specialised cooking equipment
 - ► Things for parties
 - Camping equipment













Are there any other Libraries of Things?

- Over 100 LoTs across the UK
- Various different models
- First and largest set up in Edinburgh in 2012
- First high street LoT was a pilot in south London in 2014





The Green House in numbers

- Over 60 volunteers and partner organisations
- Hosted over 40 special events
 - o including workshops, book clubs, Meet the Expert sessions, speaker events, outreach community visits e.g. library
- Sewing repair cafes may have averted 20kg of clothing waste & 225kg of CO₂ equivalent emissions in the manufacture of replacement items.
- 30 different seed varieties in our seed bank
- 2 youth climate ambassadors
- 750kg of pill blister packs diverted from landfill for recycling
- More than 700 followers on Facebook
- Participated in 2 rallies:
 - o 22nd June Restore Nature Now

3rd Nov March for Clean Water

- Over 600 hours of volunteer time
- £9/hr room hire fee
 - o networking space for your meeting/talk/workshop/club meeting venue with tv screen, Wi-Fi, tea & coffee
- Over **135** Share St Albans members in first 2 months
