# **Planetary boundaries**

NINE planetary systems working together form Earth's fundamental operating structure

climate change	ocean acidification	land use change
freshwater use	chemical pollution	aerosol pollution
ozone depletion	biogeochemical flows	biodiversity loss

Each has its own boundary that if breached will compromise the integrity of life on Earth

FOUR systems are in the boundaries' danger or uncertainty zones

### **Environmental Sustainability Plan – purpose**

TWO main categories of human-induced harm to the environment

#### Climate change –

humans burn carbon-based fossils to create energy PLUS human activity that increases all greenhouse gases TOGETHER raise atmospheric temperature that disrupts natural climate cycles

#### Ecosystems services degradation –

humanity's indifferent consumption and waste management of Earth's natural resources

## **Should SIStA operate sustainably?**

SI accepts that many human activities harm the environment Many deniers concede scientific evidence for climate change

Environmental harm threatens survival of carbon-based life INCLUDING the human species

Now that we know this, do we ignore it?

OR

Do we have a moral imperative to prevent environmental harm by changing our behaviour?

SI embraces action to prevent environmental harm
