Tiverton Sundarban Support Group has been supporting education health and skills in the village of Sundarban, North Bangladesh for 26 years.

The charity currently supports 17 preschools [30children in each]; a mother and child programme providing antenatal and postnatal care plus general health promotion; and a sewing centre training young women in theoretical and practical skills.

The newest project is a co-operative shop set up by Sally Chapman during her stay last Autumn enabling the women to purchase materials without a journey to the city.

Some of the young people who were originally pupils of the schools have now returned to Sundarban as young professionals and have set up a primary school in the area.

We are a small charity and rely on donations to support the work all money donated goes to Sundarban there are no administrative costs.
