## Directions to Brick Kiln Cottage

**From M3** take exit at Junction 6 signposted Alton (B339) follow the road past Herriard (Fur & Feathers landmark) and turn left at signposted road for Lasham Gliding Club onto the Avenue. Once you have passed Lasham Gliding Club on your right, pass a turning on the left (Back Lane), one field, a layby and then the turning immediately on your left into the woods is Brick Kiln Cottage. There will be sunflowers at the entrance!

**From Alton if coming via A31**, take the B339 signposted Basingstoke. Follow this road for 6 miles until you pass the 'Welcome to Basingstoke and Deane' sign. Take the next turning on the right (signposted for Lasham Gliding Club) onto the Avenue. Once you have passed Lasham Gliding Club on your right, pass a turning on the left (Back Lane), one field, a layby and then the turning immediately on your left into the woods is Brick Kiln Cottage. There will be sunflowers at the entrance!
