We correspond with letters from us in English and her teachers help her with the language and understanding. She wants to become a teacher herself.

She also helps with the younger children in her school and also in a Sunday school.

















Winchester Womens Refuge / St James

The club supports the Winchester Refuge and the Womens hostel in Southampton.

Throughout the year we support with donations and practical events like the Refuge picnic held in St Swithuns School, chocolates and presents at Christmas for the women and also washing up bowls with household goods for those making a start on their own.

















The club has been 'orangeing' for three years through Partnerships with the Stop Domestic Abuse agency, SI Solent East, Winchester Council and University, creating awareness of Domestic Violence.
